



Volunteer Opportunity: Business Plan Competition Judge

Background:

Every student in E CITY's programs must create a business plan for a small business venture. The students will present these plans to their class, and then six of them will be selected to present in front of a panel of judges at the final business plan competition. (They are not required to actually operate the business, but many do.)

Description of Role:

Judges listen to and evaluate the business plan presentations of our students at the competition which is the culmination of our program. Written judging criteria and forms are provided. Judges will confer and select three winners and present them with cash prizes (1st= \$150, 2nd= \$100, 3rd=\$50). Judges will also publicly affirm each of the students who made presentations.

Time Commitment:

Two to three hours the evening of the competition, typically a weekday evening at about 6:00 p.m.

Qualifications:

We prefer business leaders for this role. You will be introduced to the students before the competition begins and will have the chance to tell them about yourself.

Benefits:

You are meeting the students at the culminating event in the 70-hour program. They are nervous, yet proud. You will be in a position to give them emphatic congratulations and to help them make the connection between what they have just accomplished and their futures.
